Prayer focus for the week from CARE: HUMAN DIGNITY

SHARE THE CARE WEEK: 7-14 MARCH - raising awareness about carers' need for respite services. Loving Lord, thank You for all who sacrificially and lovingly look after someone else - especially full-time carers of those with severe disabilities, long-term illnesses and other needs requiring continuous support. Pray that more carers will receive the high standard respite and help they need. Amen.

Give thanks that valuable and ethical research using adult stem cells is being increasingly successful and well-funded. Pray about recently discovered techniques that dramatically increase the harvest of stem cells from adult tissue that this will result in less experimentation on human embryonic stem cells.

Remember people who are being treated by others in degrading and cruel ways, despised and punished because of their gender, ethnicity, religious or political beliefs, or for some so-called offence. Pray that these captives will be liberated and discover forgiveness, love and freedom in Christ.

Intercede for frail, vulnerable adults and children who are badly treated in their own homes or behind the closed doors of an institution. Pray for social workers, medical and nursing staff, teachers and others to have the wisdom and courage to know how to help them.
