### Prayer focus for the week from CARE: POLITICS AND SOCIETY

Pray for Christian politicians involved at national and local level. Ask God to help them understand how to apply biblical faith and values to real life situations in society.

Pray that legislation on equality in society will rightly protect people from ignorant prejudice and discrimination, without requiring Christians and others to deny their core orthodox religious beliefs about sexual orientation and its practice.

Pray about the growing influence of extreme right-wing racist groups in British politics. Ask God to restrain them and grant wisdom to the Government and others as they consider freedom of speech legislation.

Remember our local MP, MEP and MSP and other candidates who are preparing to stand for election. Ask God to reveal to them the genuine needs of their constituents and give them wisdom and courage as they represent and serve their communities. Pray about people's growing disaffection with politicians. Pray that the media would recognise that the majority are genuinely committed to public duty and service.

**THANKSGIVING:** Thank God for Christians who are working on behalf of their communities, acting as effective light and salt in many situations that affect ordinary people: health, education, employment, housing and other issues.
